Developing Tfm	Schools that are ready to adopt the mastery approach start here. The focus is on developing the teaching for Mastery pedagogy of the 2 participants who attend. £1,000 funding to school after full engagement with the work group 6 x half termly TRGs 3 x bespoke school visits from the Primary Mastery Specialist.			<p>Intensive Support is an agreed number of days of bespoke support for a school.</p> <p>This is for schools not currently engaging with Origin Maths Hub who would benefit from working alongside a Targeted Support Partner (TSL) over a longer period of time.</p> <p>Intensive Schools could be identified through referral or considering the following: <i>Data (EXS and Progress scores)</i> <i>Ofsted report</i> <i>FSM Eligibility</i> <i>Disadvantage %</i> <i>School's capacity</i> <i>LA/MAT partnership</i></p>
Embedding Tfm	All schools move to this phase which focuses on embedding Teaching for Mastery pedagogies across the whole school. £500 funding to school after full engagement with the work group 6 x half termly TRGs 1 x bespoke school visit from the Primary Mastery Specialist.			
Sustaining Tfm	All schools stay within this phase which establishes a supportive community to continue and further develop teaching for mastery approaches. The focus is on creating sustainable systems, deepening subject knowledge and leadership of mathematics across the school. We offer collaborative lesson design, optional twilights, subject lead sessions and open mastery lessons. It is also a great opportunity to share good practice!
